# **Registration & Fees**

All artists must register to participate. Art+Music= is open to any skill level.

To reserve your space at each concert please pay \$15 to NCMA before **25<sup>th</sup> June 2019** (cash or eftpos at NCMA reception). Include a completed Art+Music= registration form.

An additional charge of \$10 per artwork submitted into the exhibition will be payable at the Gallery. If your work is sold during the exhibition an additional 20% commission will be payable. The Gallery is not GST registered and no GST will be charged on sales.

Registration fees are not refundable, and space is strictly limited.

# Selection, Exhibition and Awards

Drop off your artwork, Gallery Registration Form and payment at Wall To Wall Art Gallery on  $31^{st}$  July 2019, 10am-4pm. You will be notified if your work has not been selected on  $2^{nd}$  August 2019. Please pick up unselected work asap. Selection is at the discretion of the judges and their decision is final.

Any 2D work, such as painting, drawing, or mixed media is allowed including 3D artwork made after the concert. Your free interpretation of subject matter inspired by the concert is encouraged. No photography. Artwork size no larger than 60cm x 70cm. Artwork must be dry and wired for hanging. Works on paper must be framed and of professional quality. All artwork must be for sale. Sold artwork will be processed within two weeks and paid into your bank account. All artwork must remain in the exhibition until it closes. Please pick up of sold and unsold artwork on **31<sup>st</sup> Aug 2019, 10am-4pm**.

David Ryan (artist) and Gill Starling (Quiet Dog Gallery) will award certificates to be presented at an opening event **5<sup>th</sup> August 2019 at 5:30 pm** at the Gallery.
